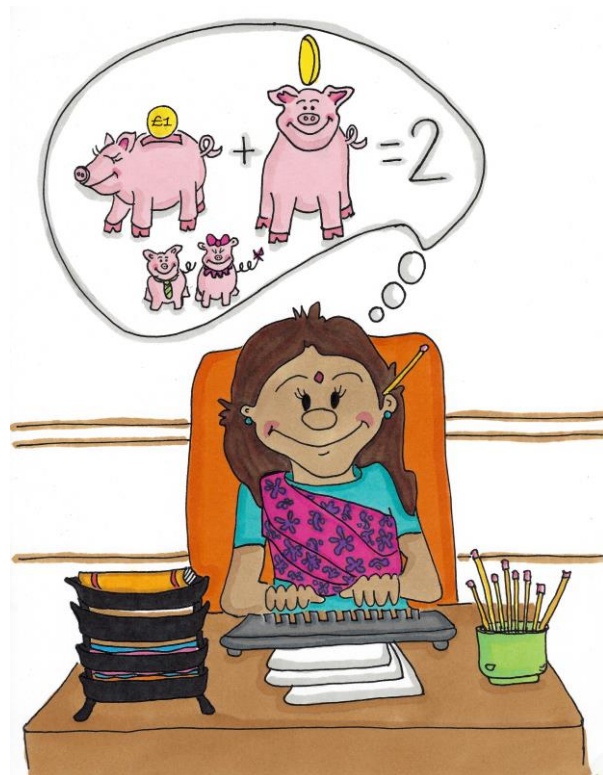


I Am Not a Doctor or a Nurse - Part 2

I am not a Doctor or a Nurse...

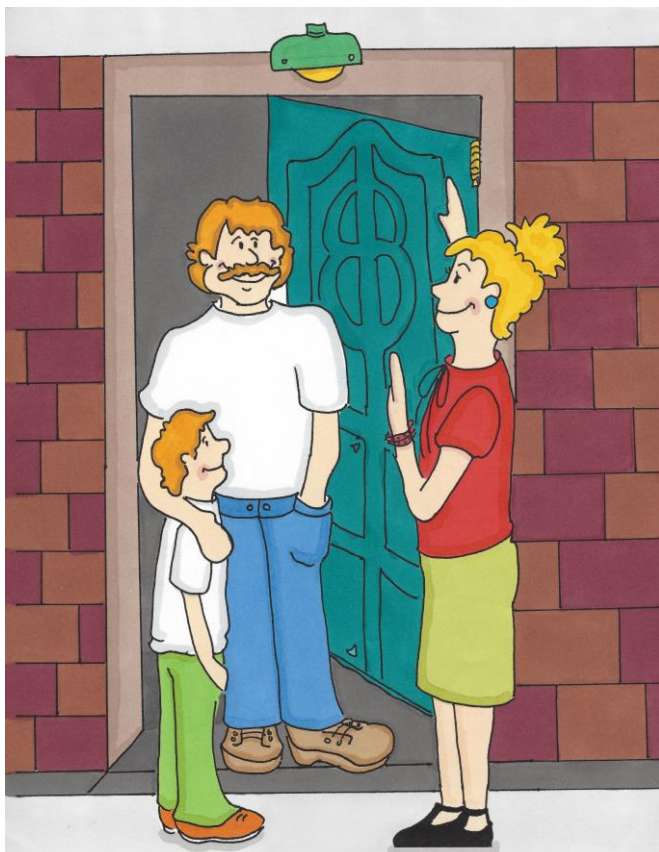
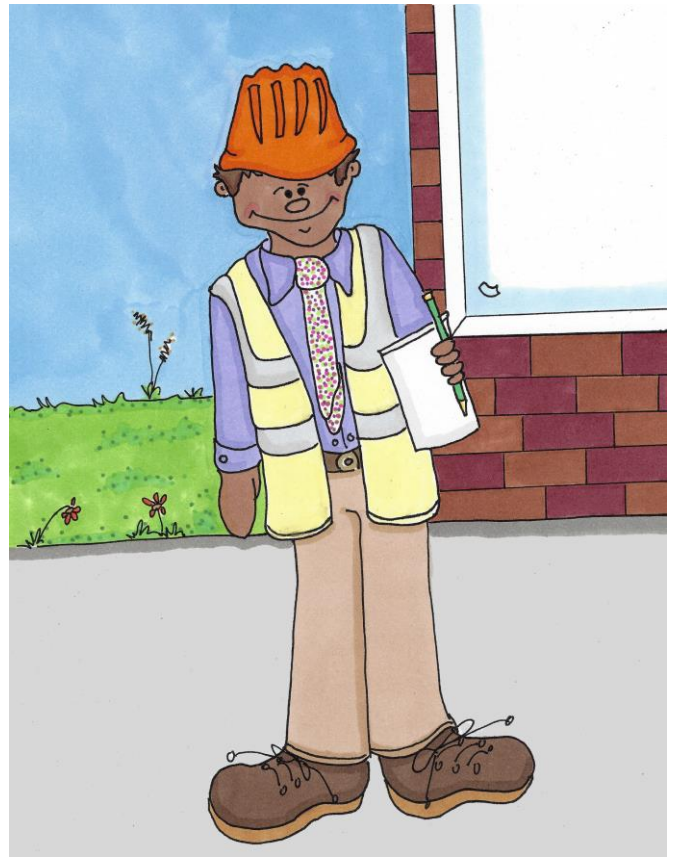
